Finding a top area then studying it until you know it and its inhabitants intimately is not just the key to bagging a wily old stag – it's the key to consistently harvesting any sambar. In the 1860's the Wonnangatta valley was established as a cattle station and a homestead was built near the junction of the Wonnangatta River and Conglomerate Creek. The pasture was improved with clover and other grasses which were fertilised for more than a hundred years. Backpacking into remote areas such as the Wonnangatta, Conglomerate Creek, Macalister River and the subalpine can be highly productive.
